Types of Bequests

Residuary bequest

This is simply a gift of whatever is left of your estate (or a percentage thereof) after all your other gifts, taxes and debts have been fulfilled.

As they are not specific amounts of money, this sort of bequest keeps its value regardless of inflation over the years. It means that the gift you include today is worth just as much when the time comes to put it to work combating Acquired Brain Injury and the grief it causes thousands of families each year.

Pecuniary bequest

This refers to leaving a gift of a set dollar amount determined by you at the time of drawing up or altering your will.

Specific bequest

This is leaving a gift of an item of specific value to be passed on to Headwest, Brain Injury Association of WA Inc. in order to generate funds.

Suggested wording for a bequest to Headwest

We recommend that you seek advice from your solicitor when making or updating your Will.

Suggested wording for a simple bequest to Headwest, Brian Injury Association of WA Inc. is as follows:

Residuary bequest

I give, devise bequeath to Headwest, Brain Injury Association of WA Inc. free from all duties, the following _____ percentage OR the remainder of my estate and direct that the receipt of the Executive Officer for the time being will be a sufficient discharge to my trustees.

Pecuniary bequest

I give devise and bequeath to Headwest, Brain Injury Association of WA Inc. free from all duties, the following \$ _____ amount and direct that the receipt of the Executive Officer for the time being will be sufficient discharge to my trustees.

Specific bequests

I give, devise and bequest to Headwest, Brain Injury Association of WA Inc. free from all duties, the following _____ item/s and direct that the receipt of the Executive Officer for the time being be sufficient discharge to my trustees.
