The Regional Landcare Facilitator (RLF) aims to support and build the capacity of these groups, to help them implement sustainable land management suited to their businesses and their area.

- Provide group facilitation.
- Assist with group planning/needs ID processes.
- Assist with governance issues.
- Assist in implementing improved project management and administration practices.

Group leaders are encouraged to contact their RLF and discuss what they believe is required for the group to function well.
